# Bible Reading: John 7.37-52

<sup>37</sup> On the last day of the festival, the great day, while Jesus was standing there, he cried out, 'Let anyone who is thirsty come to me, <sup>38</sup> and let the one who believes in me drink. As the scripture has said, "Out of the believer's heart shall flow rivers of living water." <sup>39</sup> Now he said this about the Spirit, which believers in him were to receive; for as yet there was no Spirit, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

<sup>40</sup> When they heard these words, some in the crowd said, 'This is really the prophet.' <sup>41</sup> Others said, 'This is the Messiah.' But some asked, 'Surely the Messiah does not come from Galilee, does he? <sup>42</sup> Has not the scripture said that the Messiah is descended from David and comes from Bethlehem, the village where David lived?' <sup>43</sup> So there was

a division in the crowd because of him. <sup>44</sup> Some of them wanted to arrest him, but no one laid hands on him.

<sup>45</sup> Then the temple police went back to the chief priests and Pharisees, who asked them, 'Why did you not arrest him?' <sup>46</sup> The police answered, 'Never has anyone spoken like this!' <sup>47</sup> Then the Pharisees replied, 'Surely you have not been deceived too, have you? <sup>48</sup> Has any one of the authorities or of the Pharisees believed in him? <sup>49</sup> But this crowd, which does not know the law—they are accursed.' <sup>50</sup> Nicodemus, who had gone to Jesus before, and who was one of them, asked, <sup>51</sup> 'Our law does not judge people without first giving them a hearing to find out what they are doing, does it?' <sup>52</sup> They replied, 'Surely you are not also from Galilee, are you? Search and you will see that no prophet is to arise from Galilee.'
