Ave verum corpus, natum ex Maria virgine; vere passum immolatum in cruce pro homine. Cuius latus perforatum vero fluxit sanguine. Esto nobis praegustatum mortis in examine. O clemens, O dulcis Jesu Fili Mariae. (*words: C14 hymn*)

tr: Hail, true body, born of the virgin Mary; who has truly suffered, slaughtered on the cross for humanity, from whose pierced side blood indeed did flow. Be a foretaste for us during our ordeal of death. O merciful, O sweet Jesus, Son of Mary.

As the Father has sent me, so I send you.' <sup>22</sup> When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. <sup>23</sup> If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained.'
